## GIAHS Globally Important Agricultural Heritage Systems



The Global Important Agriculture Heritage Systems - GIAHS master program is a higher education initiative of the Italian Cooperation for researchers, public administration officers, social entrepreneurs and young leaders aimed at supporting the FAO-GIAHS initiative.

FAO – GIAHS focuses on safeguard traditional agricultural systems, promote sustainable tourism, value local food production and preserve agro-biodiversity. The specific objective of the master is to train students on how to effectively **manage and identify agricultural heritage systems and landscapes**. The course will offer a very specific training on rural landscapes, creating an expert capable of informing decision-making **processes and research strategies**, in the framework of the governance of the rural territory.

The Italian Agency for International Cooperation (AICS) provides 17 **scholarships** for citizens of **Albania, Algeria, Bolivia, Bosnia, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Egypt, El Salvador, Ethiopia, Guatemala, Haiti, Honduras, Iraq, Jordan, Kenya, Lebanon, Malawi, Morocco, Mozambique, Myanmar, Nicaragua, Pakistan, Peru, Tanzania, Tunisia, Uganda, Vietnam, Zimbabwe** who are resident in their home countries.

### Application procedure

The call for the **GIAHS master program** is now open. Applications must be submitted no later than 30<sup>th</sup> October 2021.

English is the teaching language of the master.
